Focusing on Cabernet, Merlot, Malbec and other Bordeaux red varietals as well as Dry Riesling and the French Rhone varietal Marsanne for whites, Pandora Cellars aims to take the best of Washington vineyards fruit and make small quantities of palate pleasing wines.

2011 Pandora Whip and Feather Dry Riesling \$15.99

Winemaker's Tasting Notes - Exotic guava and gala apples feather your nose softly. In the mouth, the acidity cracks like the tip of the whip but it is somewhat comforting by just the right amount of sweetness to make the experience incredibly enjoyable. This wine is begging for shell fish.

2011 Pandora "Bellevue Blond" Marsanne \$15.99

Winemaker's Tasting Notes - This Marsanne has weight in the mouth but is backed up by refreshing acidity. The aromas consist of lemon and pineapple and flavors of melons and guava. A perfect match for white fish and chicken-based meals. 100% malolactic conversion, stainless steel fermented and aged sur lie for 5 months.

2010 Pandora Petit Sirah/Syrah \$24.99

Winemaker's Tasting Notes - A California style blend with a Washington twist. This wine is very dark in color, has bright cool climate acidity and oozing blackberry and spice. Moderate tannis make this wine approachable now and a great match with grilled meats.

60% Petit Sirah - Lonesome Spring Ranch Vineyard, Yakima Valley / 40% Syrah - Double Canyon Vineyard, Horse Heaven Hills

2010 Pandora Conner's Blend \$26.99

Winemaker's Tasting Notes - Our signature Bordeaux style blend is named after our owners' first-born son. It's a bit "backwards" for a Bordeaux blend in that the Malbec and Petit Verdot make up the majority of the blend. The aroma is showing bright cherry with leather and dusty earth tones. Its fruit is spicy with dark cherry and a hint of banana peel. The wine has some tightly wound tannins that open up over time and solid acidity that promise aging ability yet still enjoyable now.

40% Malbec / 40% Petit Verdot - Double Canyon Vineyard, Horse Heaven Hills / 20% Cabernet - Elephant Mountain, Yakima Valley

2010 Pandora Black Velvet \$26.99

Winemaker's Tasting Notes - Classic Sangiovese aromas of dusty cherries and wet rocks hit your nose, this wine has drying tannins but is backed up with ample dark fruits thanks to the Klipsun Merlot. A great match with red pasta dishes and pizza.

60% Sangiovese - Elephant Mountain, Yakima Valley / 40% Merlot - Klipsun Vineyard, Red Mountain

2010 Pandora Cabernet Sauvignon/Cabernet Franc \$29.99

Winemaker's Tasting Notes - The power and structure of Klipsun Cabernet combined with the aromatic and supple Meek Franc produce a wine highly unique in style for Washington State. Explosive on the nose with candy like red raspberries, the flavors turn to dark fruit with a silky but structured mouth feel, the tannins are present, but refined. 100% once-used French oak.

50% Cabernet - Klipsun Vineyard, Red Mountain / 50% Cabernet Franc - Meek Vineyard, Yakima Valley
