This Friday evening from 4 to 7 p.m. Wicked Cellars features Stephanie Cuffel with the latest releases from Woodinville's Patterson Cellars. Please welcome Stephanie as she shares some of Patterson Cellars' newest releases with us this Friday evening!

Patterson Cellars works its magic in the Woodinville wine warehouse district and operates a popular winery tasting room at Hollywood Hill located near Chateau Ste. Michelle in Woodinville.

Using grapes sourced from Columbia Valley, Red Mountain, Lake Chelan and Horse Heaven Hills AVAs Patterson provides consistent quality, creating approachable wines in the new world wine style.

Focused on creating wine as unique as the grape itself, and over the years Patterson Cellars has developed a close following among oenophiles who expectantly await the truly extraordinary wines that they release year after year.

2011 Patterson Cellars Forbidden Rosé \$13.99

Released this past May, this Columbia Valley blend of Tempranillo, Syrah, Sangiovese and splashes of Cabernet Franc, Barbera, Grenache and Merlot is red-orange in color and boasts enticing aromas of strawberry and baker's yeast. Layers of fruit swathe the palate, seeming quite dry yet with a perception of sweetness on the finish. The fermentation was kept cool in stainless steel tanks to preserve freshness and aromatics. Release: May 2012

2011 Patterson Cellars Chardonnay \$21.99

Hints of vanilla come at the end of an aromatic citrus-apple bouquet in this 100% Chardonnay sourced from Sagecliffe Vineyards. On the palate it offers crisp acidity,

strong flinty minerality and the roundness that comes from almost full malolactic fermentation.

NV Woodslake Due Anni \$15.99

Due Anni, meaning “two years” in Italian, is comprised of wine from the 2009 and 2010 vintages. A blend of six different Columbia Valley varietals, led by Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Merlot, are showcased in this wine that offers layers of bright fruits followed by notes of pepper and clove. The mid palate offers a hint of sweetness to balance its smoky finish.

2008 Patterson Cellars Cabernet Franc \$29.99

A great follow-up to the 2007 Cabernet Franc, the deep ruby 2008 Patterson Cellars Cabernet Franc offers aromas of dark fruit and violets on the nose. Luscious red and black fruit flavors, along with notes of spice and minerality create a medium to full-bodied palate.

Crisp acidity with herbal notes complement a mélange of bright cherry, dark fruit and chocolate flavors. Medium, sweet tannins create a balance between acidity and texture.

2008 Patterson Cellars BDX Bordeaux Blend \$34.99

This Columbia Valley blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Merlot is deep red with a bouquet of eucalyptus, wild violets, Asian spice, cassis, and boysenberry. It will age beautifully because of its blend of tannins, fruit and acid that shape the wine's character.

2009 Patterson Cellars Syrah \$34.99

Normally a Wine Club only wine, this Syrah shows aromas of black fruit, cigar box and burnt sugar. Silky smooth in texture with by dark fruit flavors with a soft and smoky finish, this 100% Syrah is pure pleasure in a glass.
