Owned and operated by **Bart and Chona Fawbush**, **Bartholomew Winery** is a small winery born out of a love affair with wine. Tucked away in the old Rainier Brewery on Airport Way, Bartholomew Winery is the newest of the South Seattle Artisan Wineries and is known for its beautifully balanced Rhone and Bordeaux style blends from grapes sourced from some of the finest vineyards in Washington's Columbia Valley.

Bartholomew Winery was featured in the article "Top 10 New Washington Wines 2011" by *Seattle Magazine* in August 2011 and ranked at Number 17 by *Sunset Magazine* among their annual "Top Cultural Trends Shaping the West" in their February 2012 issue.



Wine bloggers have raved about how welcoming and friendly owner and winemaker Bart Fawbush is to guests in his tasting room. So we thought that we would save you the drive to Sodo/Georgetown, and on Saturday between 4:00 and 7:00 p.m. we're bringing Bart to Wicked Cellars. Come in, say, "hi" and taste some fabulous Washington wine!

2009 Bartholomew Tempranillo \$32.99

This 100% Tempranillo from Upland Vineyard in the Snipes Mountain AVA, the oldest

AVA in Washington, planted with vines since 1914. We can't wait for you to taste this Spanish grape with a Washington slant!

2009 Bartholomew Malbec \$31.99

Released just this past May, this 100% Malbec from the **Rattlesnake Hills** presents a bouquet of warm, cooked plums and a spicy palate showing tart red cherry. Here's a wine that brings almost immediately to mind, even with vegetarians!

2007 Bartholomew Cuvee Rouge \$27.99

This Columbia Valley blend of Carmenere, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot is a black cherry red with a jammy nose of cooked fruit and a dark fruit palate hinting of earth.

2009 Bartholomew Cabernet Franc \$30.99

From the fine vines at **Coyote Canyon Vineyard** in the **Horse Heaven Hills**, in this wine dark chocolate collides with black berries that burst on your palate. Big and bold flavors abound and French oak barrels kiss this wine with a touch of vanilla.

2008 Bartholomew Jaxon \$33.99

Sourced from Walla Walla's famous **Pepperbridge Vineyard**, this blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot with Cabernet Franc and Malbec is named for Bart's son, Jaxon. Aged in 50% new French oak and 50% neutral oak, this is a big wine showing equal parts blackberry and **Barry White**. You've got to try it, baby; you know you want it!
