#### **Boating Results for January**

Shellharbour R3 Carnival was the best SCBS carnival this season with a strong southerly sweep and 1.5-2m waves dumping on the sand bar early - providing a "challenging" event. Unfortunately the Nautti Buoys (U23 Men) came to grief in the first round, when trying to avoid another boat on the way out, resulting in a trip to hospital for 'General' Joe Zautsen but no lasting damage was done to people or equipment. Open Women's crew, the Black Cats, decided that these were not the conditions for our newbie rower's second ever surf session and pulled out after one start. Great effort by the girls to stick around and help move boats for the rest of the day for those crews who continued to compete! Young Guns was held at Collaroy mid-Jan. This carnival is specifically for the younger age divisions with crews from all over Australia competing. Woonona was represented by the Nautti Buoys and Aquaholics (U23 Women). Though neither crew made it past the round robin, they both showed some good potential, generally keeping up with the rest of the crews on the way out to the cans. More cardio work will see them able to maintain that form better on the way home!

The final carnival for January was the Manly Open. All our junior crews (except the U19 Gunners) competed. Instructors missed out by just 1 point to go into the elimination rounds but both JAKKS and Spaghetti Hoes made it through until Sunday. Elimination was pretty tough with JAKKS out early in the day but the SH's continued through and made it to the Final! By this time, the tide was out and boats were starting on the bar. The check starter, in his wisdom, called Woonona to move south into the gutter. The gun went off, Chivo had to jump from waist deep water into the boat, causing it to tip. Bow side took a full stroke, stroke side missed and the Rat went head first into Bilgola Benny's. Both crews stopped dead, had to regroup and came 6th and 5th respectively which was a very disappointing end to a good carnival.
