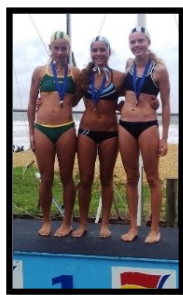
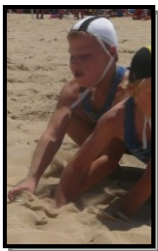
NSW Surf Lifesaving Age Championship 1 – 3 March Ocean Beach – Umina – Ettalong - Terrigal
