Two Mountain Winery is a small family-owned operation nestled in the Rattlesnake Hills within the Yakima Valley wine region of Washington State. Brothers Matthew and Patrick Rawn own and operate the winery and estate vineyard, drawing on the experience of three generations of their family who have farmed the rich soil of the Yakima Valley since 1951.

Matt Rawn, who will be with us this Saturday, is Two Mountain's Winemaker and Director of Sales and Marketing. He helped plant Two Mountains' estate vineyard with his uncle Ron Schmidt in 2000 and has been winemaker since their first vintage in 2002.

Two Mountain 2011 Estate Chardonnay \$19.99

This is a classic Chardonnay offering aromas of caramelized banana and vanilla, followed by a palate of toasty butterscotch and overripe pear with a lingering finish.

Two Mountain 2011 Estate Riesling \$12.99

Aromas of hay, green pear and wild flowers combine with incredible flavors of ripe citrus and green apple. This wine offers a wonderful minerality and light dry finish that lasts forever on your tongue to remind of summers gone by and summers yet to come!

Two Mountain 2009 Estate Syrah \$21.99

This rich Syrah boasts aromas of blueberry cobbler, rich old leather, and vanilla paired with flavors of blackberry, ripe huckleberry, white pepper, and rich, ripe fig. It finishes soft, but not flabby, just as a Washington Syrah should!

Two Mountain 2009 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon \$26.99

Aromas of bramble berries, leather and cedar combine with flavors of dark berry, currant, charred oak and a soft, yet long lasting finish to leave you wanting more, more, and more of this Cabernet!

Two Mountain 2009 Estate Cabernet Franc Reserve \$36.99

Deep, dark garnet in color, this Cabernet Franc offers rich aromas of dried berries and stone fruits along with coconut yogurt, and praline with flavors of red fruit, bell pepper, and spice on the palate. It boasts a supple, and well-balanced medium body and a tangy, blackberry and honeycomb finish with chewy tannins.

Two Mountain Estate Touriga Nacional Port-Style Wine \$42.99

Here's an authentic deep and rich Port style wine from Two Mountain made from one of the premier grapes used in Portugal's Duoro Valley, the Touriga Nacional grape, but grown right here in Washington! It's a great way to cap our tasting of Two Mountain wines this Saturday.
