We've got a rosé for ever palate, and they are always great with picnics and barbeque. Some of these are in very short supply, so come in and taste a little bit of summer (even if its raining!)

#### 2012 Domaine de Couron Ardeche Rosé \$9.99

What's a summer day without a refreshing glass of rosé? This delightful wine is crafted by Jean-Luc and Marie-Lise Dorthe of Domaine de Couron, nestled in the tiny village of Saint Marcel d'Ardeche, France.

#### 2012 Saint Nabor "Gris de Nabor" Rosé \$10.99

Bright with a raspberry pink tint, this rosé offers red fruit aromas and honeysuckle. It is light, crisp and easy drinking, with bright red fruit flavors of wild strawberries and blueberries with mineral nuances.

#### 2012 Le Provencal Cotes de Provence Rosé \$10.99

"Le Provencal" Cotes de Provence Rosé captures all the warmth of the sun-drenched Provençal countryside: forested rocky hills, rugged garrigue plains and the sparkling Mediterranean seacoast.

## 2012 Commanderie de la Bargemone Couteaux d'Aix en Provence Rosé, Provence \$16.99

Among the foremost estates of the Coteaux d'Aix appellation of Provence, the Commanderie was founded by Templar knights in the13th century. Its rosé offers classic aromas of wild strawberries and red currants, with a light, floral character and a crisp, bone-dry palate.

## 2012 Alpaltagua Rosé, Chile \$11.99

From Chile's Central Valley, this rosé made from Carmènere, Chile's signature red is a delightfully refreshing wine with tingling acidity.

## 2012 Hogwash Rosé - \$12.99

### 2012 Tranche Cellars Pink Pape, Columbia Valley \$17.99

The 2012 Pink Pape Estate rosé is a blend of Counoise, Cinsault and Grenache. Soft and lush on the palate with red berry fruits complemented by delicate flavors of white nectarine, orange blossom and hibiscus flower, it has mouthwatering acidity that leads to a lingering finish.
