# Wicked Cellars Tasting Notes Friday, May 31st, 4:00 to 7:00 p.m. Walla Walla's Bergevin Lane Vineyards \$10 Tasting Fee

Bergevin Lane 2012 Dreamweaver Roussanne \$26.99

Silky butterscotch melts into tangerine and citrus on the nose as slices of melon, orange and pear cover the palate of this blend of 88% Roussanne and 12% Viognier.

18.5/20 points—Review of Washington Wines / June 2013

Bergevin Lane 2012 "She Devil" Chardonnay \$21.99

Honeysuckle, grapefruit and apple aromas abound is this blend of 81% Chardonnay, 17% Roussanne and 2% Viognier. The palate is apple jolly rancher, peach and pear. The crisp finish is pineapple, citrus and honey crisp apple.

The Roussanne adds abroad citrus element to the mid-palate and finish, while the Viognier adds a peachy lift to the aroma profile.

Bergevin Lane 2010 "Wild Child" Merlot, Wahluke Slope \$29.99

90% Merlot, 5% Malbec and 5% Petit Verdot from Stone Tree Vineyard in the Wahluke Slope, this is Bergevin Lane's first single vineyard Merlot! Ripe and juicy, this is a stunning expression of Washington State Merlot.

The nose expressed powdery anise and sweet plums over bright blueberries. In the mouth, layers of blackberry flow through a lovely mixture of dark chocolate and cherry- with just a hint of cigar box in the background.

# Bergevin Lane 2010 Moonspell Cabernet, Columbia Valley \$29.99

Dark and deep shadows of anise hover over candied blackberry and deep cocoa aromas as silken cherry spreads over a thick layer of cassis, followed by waves of blackberry and currants that flood the palate. The finish ripples with anise and bittersweet chocolate on a pond of blue and blackberries.

This is a blend of 82% Cabernet Sauvignon, 6% Merlot, 6% Malbec & 6% Petite Verdot from Stone Tree Vineyards in the Wahluke Slope, Double Canyon Vineyard in the Horse Heaven Hills, Pepper Bridge Vineyard in Walla Walla and Dionysus Vineyard in the Yakima Valley.

## Bergevin Lane 2008 Barrel Select Syrah \$38.99

This 100% Syrah from the Wahluke Slope's Stone Tree Vineyard and Walla Walla's Francisca's Vineyard opens with a deep and brooding nose of dark fruits, smoke and meat entangled with crushed lavender and minerals. On the palate it's penetrating and substantial with spice, cedar and vanilla and dense, almost thick in the mouth.

### Bergevin Lane 2009 "Princess" Syrah \$51.99

This single vineyard Syrah showcases Walla Walla terroir with its inky color, concentrated nose of sweet earth, dark fruit and minerality and its smooth and elegant palate, that hints of earth, dark fruits, game and sweet oak.
