It is important that you carry your membership card with you at all times while on Club premises, or using Club facilities.

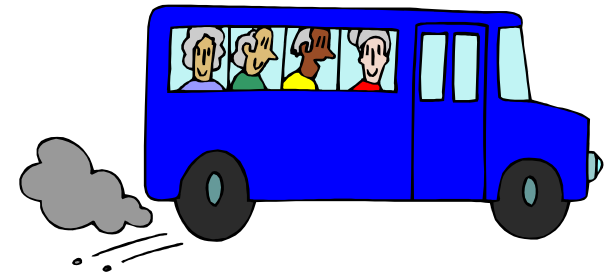

This is played every Tuesday night from 7.30pm. Tickets are on sale from 6pm.

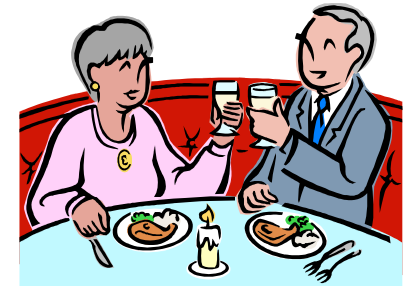
Housie is a good asset to our Club, and we have completed a number of Club improvements from Housie proceeds:-
