

Message for all Bronze Medallion and SRC holders, Each year we undertake Award Skills Maintenance (Proficiency). The dates for this year are; 10th Nov, 17th Nov, 1st Dec, 15th Dec and 22nd Dec. They will commence in the courtyard at 10am for each date with the dry component and move to the beach for the timed swim and rescues at 11am. You are welcome to attend whichever date you prefer. If the dates are not possible, please contact us as soon as you know (before 22nd Dec) so we can discuss options, however, other than in exceptional circumstances, no other proficiencies are planned to be conducted.

Just a couple of changes this year, the wet and dry components of the Bronze Medallion and SRC will be done on the same day and all awards (incl. ARTC, Spinal etc.) will also be completed on the day. I have also attached a SLSA document setting out the requirements for each award in more detail for those who are interested.
