Mollydooker is an Aussie term for Left-Hander. Since both Sarah and Sparky Marquis, the husband and wife winemaking team behind Mollydooker, are both lefties they chose this name for their exciting, out of left field winery in the heart of Australia's McLaren Vale.

2012 The Violinist (Verdelho) \$26.99

"This wine is fantastic. It was exciting to taste it through all the winemaking stages, because it always kept the fresh vibrant fruit that was there the night we picked the grapes. I see tropical fruit bowl, citrus, pear and a creamy texture. For me, it's the creamy texture that makes this wine so enjoyable, just like fruit salad and ice cream." ~ Sparky ~

2012 The Maître D' (Cabernet Sauvignon) \$26.99

"Rich, round and complex, this wine is simply awesome. The Maître D' has an enticing perfumed nose of blackberry, plum, cigar box and a touch of cinnamon. Overwhelming flavors of blackcurrant and dark cherry carry forward, accompanied by mouth filling layers of mocha, spice and vanilla."

2012 Two Left Feet (Shiraz/Cabernet/Merlot) \$26.99

Two Left Feet always exceeds expectations; it is magical how well it comes together. Shiraz, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon work together brilliantly! The combination brings complexity and depth to this wine.

The Two Left Feet is amazing with real complexity of aromas on the nose and displays a fruit flavor spectrum showing beautiful dark berry and plum fruit with lots of spice. The palate is round and filling and shows concentrated sweet fruits with layers of chocolate and cream.

2012 The Boxer Shiraz \$26.99

The very first person to taste this wine said "It's a knockout!" so they named it The Boxer.

"The 2012 Boxer really packs a punch. It is rich and opulent, revealing an enormous lift of cherry, spice, and milk chocolate. It has a massive array of flavors, and awesome intensity but the thing that really finishes the wine off is the creamy layers and smooth mouth feel. It's so voluptuous." ~ Peter & Andrew ~

Gigglepot 2011 Cabernet Sauvignon \$55.99

The 2011 Gigglepot is distinctly Cabernet, from the intensity of dark fruits to the direct tannins and fresh acidity. Completely balanced in every way, it offers layers and layers of sweet fruit rolling over dark chocolate, and a rich creamy palate. It ends with anise spice and lingering coffee flavors. Stunning!

The Miss Molly Sparkling Shiraz \$29.99

Seriously tasty, this wine will give you all sorts of reasons to celebrate and pop another bottle. It's focused on fresh red berries but also shows great layers of complexity, chocolate and cream, spice, fine tannins and soft luscious sparkling finish.
