International Roaming; Vodafone vs. Telecom

I've been with Vodafone for years and years, and have used my cell phone overseas many times before, mainly for text messaging and calling. Make a call before I leave home, arrive at my destination and turn on the phone - easy as that. It's extremely convenient to text or call home for quick updates, say hello and, most importantly, brag about all your fun travel experiences! It's also great to be able to make local calls to make restaurant reservations, reconfirm onwards flights, book taxis and to meet up with your new found friends. However it can be costly (I can vouch for that after a long phone call home from Croatia).

I must say I was pretty surprised at all the commotion when Telecom released their new 'XT Mobile Network' and still can't really understand what all the fuss is about Like I said, I'd already been roaming with Vodafone for years. So I decided to do a bit of research, here's what I found:

Telecom: Not all phones are compatible for roaming. However Telecom does offer a free loan phone if your current phone won't work in your destination. Look out for upgrade credits when purchasing a new XT Mobile. If you are on a contract you'll be able to Roam in more than 210 destinations for voice and texting across more than 430 networks worldwide - and

over 110 destinations for data. If you're on Prepaid, you can now roam to many countries too; however you'll be slightly limited. The one thing I really did like the sound of is the set fees over 5 Zones, which makes it easy to know what you'll be getting charged per call (incoming or outgoing), text message or your data usage. Telecom is also able to email some Roaming Tips before you depart on your holiday, and have worldwide support via a toll free number or email.

Vodafone: All Vodafone cell phones are compatible to roam. Vodafone is the world's largest global mobile network, so they offer a quality roaming experience with the Vodafone group and network partners. They offer roaming to over 215 destinations for voice and 90 for data (less for prepaid customers). Vodafone has a new 'Vodafone Traveller' zone based roaming pricing plan, split into four zones. So when you roam and make a call when overseas you will only pay the standard rate you pay when you use your mobile in New Zealand, plus the zone rate per minute. You do need to opt in for this new pricing plan. If you don't opt in I'd highly recommend printing out the network pricing details for each country you are going to, as you'll need to manually select the network you use for each call. One may offer better local calling rates, whereas the other network may be best when calling home. All On Account customers can call customer services for free when roaming overseas.


So all in all they both seem pretty competitive with each other (reminds me of Air NZ vs. Qantas, always copying each other!). I'll be sticking with Vodafone for now, seems like Telecom is really only just catching up with what Vodafone have been offering for years....
