This artists' collaboration was conceptualized by John E. Bates of Black Horse Art Supply in Burlington, Vermont in an effort to create awareness and to raise contribution for Andy William's diagnosis with leukemia in the fall of 2012. The work also includes drawn content from another Vermont artist, Josie Furchgott Sourdiffé, Andy's partner. "Adog For Life — Homage" was realized over the course of three weeks in August 2013 with generosity from the community and Andy's peers.

Seeking to transfer drawn analog and digital work to a large picture-plane, the artists used a variety of masking techniques in the creation of these six panels. The process used was parallel to that used by Andy in mixing music — it is very additive, serial and layered. It also used die-cut vinyl as a masking tool to pay homage to Andy's process. The successive layers of vinyl were ultimately peeled away to selectively expose the colorfully painted work underneath. Knowing that no work of art, be it musical or visual, could truly echo Andy's contribution to his own medium both locally and nationally: the artists humbly seek to convey their appreciation for his life's work in a way kindred to his vibrant artistic sense.

In honor of all those who are or have struggled with leukemia, this work is being used to raise funds and awareness. The businesses showing this work are making donations to this cause. Any contribution continues the reciprocation this work embodies. Together, his community and listeners can further the fullness with which DJ ADOG loved life.
