Background & History

Why are we doing a KiwiSport Consultation?

Sport Whanganui oversee and distribute the KiwiSport fund within the Whanganui, Rangitikei and Ruapehu regions. Every three years we need to consult with our community to ensure that the KiwiSport RPF priorities that were established from our community consultation in 2012 are still relevant, and to ensure maximum impact on our community over the coming three years.

What priorities were identified in 2012?

The following are the priorities that were identified as a result of the 2012 KiwiSport Consultation:

- Fundamental Movement Skills programmes within primary schools
- Coaching programmes for coaches directly impacting kiwi kids
- Events or transport
- New and innovative projects

How are we doing this Consultation?

- Face to face consultation through Sport Whanganui sport development team
- Various community forums
