Zane Town of Year 10, lost his life in a motor accident on Saturday. His mother's life was also taken.

Joshua Hill, an ex-pupil (2011), was fatally shot in a hunting accident also on Saturday.

Both young men were well liked by staff and have many friends, both pupils and staff, in the School.

We extend our sincere condolences to both families.

As a mark of respect to both families, and as both funerals are on Friday 15 May at 2.00pm the School will be closing at 12.50pm. We will run periods 1, 2 and 3. This will allow staff and pupils to attend if they wish.
