A Mission Continues Fellowship is an opportunity for military veterans involving 20 hours of service per week for 26 weeks at a local nonprofit organization. Fellows are encouraged to choose a nonprofit organization to serve based on their own personal passions. The specific description for SOS is as follows:

Position Title: Service Learning Coordinator

Job Responsibilities: The Service Learning Coordinator position will be focused on the development and execution of the service learning aspect of SOS programming. 80% of the fellow's time will be spent on service project management, 10% will be spent on workshop delivery, and 10% will be spent on assisting SOS programs staff in the execution of SOS Programs. The position will require 20 hours a week over the 6 month fellowship.

- Specifically, responsibilities will include the following:
 - o Scheduling, developing, and executing service learning projects for atrisk youth in the SOS Outreach University program.
 - Maintaining and building relationships with service learning partner organizations.
 - Leading service learning projects through direct service.
 - Tracking youth service learning attendance.
 - Preparing and executing workshops aimed at leadership development and service learning.
 - Supporting SOS Outreach staff in the preparation and execution of programs, events, and awareness days.

Job Requirements

- Experience, comfort, and passion in working with disadvantaged youth.
- Awareness of factors impacting lives of underserved youth.
- Interest in and experience with outdoor based sports and activities such as camping, rock climbing, rafting, skiing, snowboarding and backpacking.
- Must be an independent worker with an ability to thrive in a dynamic work environment.
- Excellent written and oral communications.
- Ability to lead and motivate staff, volunteers, and youth. -Proficiency with computer programs including Microsoft Office Suite.
- Spanish Language proficiency and cultural literacy (Preferred).
