Classes of Membership:

- (a) **Ordinary** membership consists of one person over 25 years of age. Ordinary membership entitles such members to full use of all the Club's facilities. This class of membership has one vote for any matter voted on at an Annual or Special General Meeting;
- (b) **Junior** membership consists of one person under the age of 25 years. Junior membership entitles such members to full use of all the Club's facilities. This class of membership has one vote for any matter voted on at an Annual or Special General Meeting;
- (c) **Family** membership consists of one person and his or her partner both over 18 years of age together with all of their children under 18 years of age, together these individuals will constitute one Family membership. Family membership entitles such members to full use of all the Club's facilities. This class of membership has two votes for any matter voted on at an Annual or Special General Meeting, such votes may only be exercised by those Family members who are over 18 years of age;
- (d) **Associate** membership consists of one person and his or her partner both over 18 years of age together with all of their children under 18 years of age, together these individuals will constitute one Associate membership. To be eligible as an Associate membership, those individuals must not:
 - (i) Own a boat (except a dinghy);
 - (ii) Race other than as crew; or
 - (iii) Be granted a dinghy locker or haulage privileges,

The following restrictions apply to this class of membership:

- (iv) No voting rights at any Annual or Special General Meetings and not eligible to hold office;
- (v) No more than 50% of all memberships of the Club may be Associate members at any one time, the General Committee holds the right to review this percentage; and
- (vi) The General Committee may review an Associate's membership annually, renewal of Associate membership is not automatic. Any Associate subscription fees paid may be offset against Ordinary, Family or Junior subscription fees;

Procedure:

On receipt of an application for membership with the appropriate payment the application will be referred to the General Committee at its next meeting. If approved by the Committee the name(s) of the applicant(s) will be posted on the Club notice board for a period of 2 weeks. Provided there are no objections or concerns raised by Club members the applicant(s) will, at the end of the 2 weeks, be added to the membership roll. A membership card will be sent to the address advised.

Newsletter and Yearbook:

New members will receive a copy of the current yearbook and those who have provided an email address will receive the monthly newsletter by email unless post is specifically requested.
