She has considerable experience teaching in a variety of settings including teaching private lessons since 1999.

## PIANO LESSONS

### Individual Lessons- Ages 4-6

Half-hour weekly lessons are given for all beginning students. This class is designed for students who wish to develop basic piano playing skills and learn basic music theory.

*15 individual lessons and monthly group classes.

### Individual Lessons- Ages 6-11

Half-hour weekly lessons are given for all beginning students. 40-minute weekly lessons are given for students who have taken piano lessons at least one year (Parents can choose either half-hour or 40-minute weekly lessons depending on ages). This class is designed for students who wish to develop basic piano playing skills, or expand on their existing skills. Students will develop effective practice techniques and learn music theory.

### Individual Lessons- Ages 11-18

Parents can choose either 40-minute or 50-minute weekly lessons depending on ages. Student will have learned to play some of the standards of piano repertoire while gaining a thorough understanding of the history and basic concepts of music.

*15 individual lessons and monthly group classes.  
End of semester recital  
\$500 plus cost of music (40 minute)  
\$625 plus cost of music (50 minute)*

## ORGAN LESSONS

### Individual Lessons for Adults

Students can choose either 30-minute or 40-minute weekly lessons. This class is designed to introduce beginning exercises in coordination of manual and pedal playing. Also, students will have learned to play some of the standards of organ repertoire and hymns.
