Following the Christmas Day launch party, *bouquet* will ring in the New Year with a lavish celebration, featuring an extensive menu of canapes and cocktails, making it a night to remember.

Revellers looking to rest their heads can settle down in one of Le Grand Bellevue's 57 sumptuous rooms and suites, whilst the 3,000 sqm *Le Grand Spa* offers the perfect place to wind

down. Skiers can explore Gstaad's 220km of powdery pistes, before enjoying Michelin starred cuisine in the hotel's bistro-style restaurant, *LEONARD's*, or tucking into hearty fondue in the cosy surrounds of *Le Petit Chalet*.
