# **Pastoral Reflections**

On an annual basis, the senior pastor is required to submit a written report to the Charge Conference. It has been my practice

for the past several years that I also share the report with the entire congregation via the church newsletter. By doing so, it is my hope that a culture of transparency is encouraged within the faith community.

# PASTOR'S REPORT TO THE 2016 CHARGE CONFERENCE

Last fall you may recall that I shared with you the three goals that Westlake UMC would be focusing on in the upcoming Charge Conference year. Those goals were: establish an administrative foundation; focus on spiritual formation for the congregation; and develop a missional strategy addressing local, regional, national, and international opportunities. Church leadership, staff, and parishioners have all worked together over the past year to achieve these goals.

The 2013, 2014, and 2015 financial audits have been completed and submitted to our District Superintendent. The structure of the church staff has been formalized and communicated via a new organizational chart. A review of staff benefits has been completed and necessary adjustments have been made. Job descriptions have been drafted. They are being reviewed and approved by the Staff Parish Relations Committee (SPRC). In addition, annual performance feedback was provided to all staff in January 2016.

There has been a strong focus on spiritual formation for the congregation. Last fall, Sacred Rhythms: Arranging Our Lives for Spiritual Transformation was studied by over 40% of our average worship attendance. Individuals and groups have been encouraged to practice the spiritual disciplines learned in this study. In response to the very positive feedback on spiritual formation we received from parishioners, a spring day retreat was held with Rev. Dr. Valerie Stultz leading a discussion on Richard Rohr's book, Falling Upward. In addition, a dedicated time of individual prayer has been added to our weekly contemporary worship service.

Throughout 2016, the Mission Team has worked diligently to establish a missional strategy for our church. In each of our worship services on October 16, 2016 the WUMC missional strategy was communicated. If you were unable to attend any of the worship services on the 16<sup>th</sup>, I encourage you to watch the archive of that service which can be found on the church web site.

As we move into our new Charge Conference year, it is our intention to build on these goals. This fall, the SPRC and the Leadership Council have approved the following goals for WUMC: continue to strengthen our administrative foundation; maintain a focus on spiritual formation for the congregation with an emphasis on spirit-led leadership; and execute our missional strategy. One way we plan to strengthen our administrative foundation is by updating personnel related tools. We also plan to work with staff to help them grow as disciples of Jesus Christ through their participation in a book study of *Five Practices of Fruitful Congregations* and in a day retreat that will focus on prayer.

We will maintain a focus on spiritual formation through spirit-led leadership as the Leadership Council continues its study of *Pursuing God's Will Together: A Discernment Practice for Leadership Groups.* In January 2017, Leadership Council members will go on retreat as they conclude the study of this book and move forward with integrating the practices learned into decision-making for all matters related to the church. In the coming months you will hear more about a very important day retreat planned for the church. On February 25, 2017 Rev. Dr. Sue Nilson Kibbey will be coming to WUMC to lead a retreat on her new book, *Flood Gates: Holy Momentum for a Fearless Church.* Bishop Gregory Palmer wrote the foreword for the book.

Lastly, the Mission Team will execute the strategy that was developed this year for local, regional, national, and international mission. One key area that we will focus on in 2017 is expanding our relationship with Simpson UMC. Our two churches have long been ministry partners, and we will identify ways in which we can grow this important relationship as we make and mature disci-







