WEDNESDAY 2 NOVEMBER

NCEA Examinations begin on Wednesday 9 November. Students will be issued with their admission slips on their last day. We do a roll check at each examination, and parents will be phoned if we cannot account for a student's absence. There is a half hour window of opportunity for students to get here if they have made a mistake about the time of an examination.
