#### MOBILIZE:

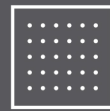

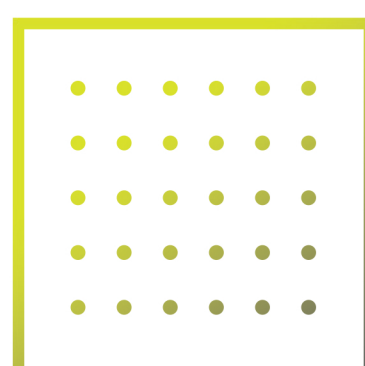
# NEW YEAR, NEW NAME!

**257  
PEOPLE**

Last year 257 people surrendered to Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior in our weekend worship services!

**164 NEW  
MEMBERS**

We rejoice that 164 new members, including 39 kids, have a church home with us. Of the 125 new members, 85% were received by profession or reaffirmation of faith!

**OVER  
2,000**

We saw more than 2,000 people participate in our weekend-based small groups. And we increased the number of on-going small groups by 20%.

PEOPLE**

Over 75 people participated in Dave Ramsey's Financial Peace University.

Our 33 care teams with 417 members reached out more than 5,000 times with messages, prayers, visits, and other caring actions.

STUDENTS**

We celebrated 125 students who surrendered to Christ for this year, including RIOT Summer Camp.

We averaged 239 middle and high school students who attended our weekly student programming.

CAMPERS**

Riot Summer Camp had 185 middle and high school students, 30 student leaders, and more than 100 volunteers serve at more than 70 work sites in our community.

433 preschool and elementary campers participated in Sports Camp, along with the help of 218 volunteers.

CHILDREN**

To date, Suncoast Kid's Place has ministered to 3,500+ children and their families, helping them experience hope and healing from the loss of a significant person in their lives.

FLORIDA**

We provided mentoring to more than 500 incarcerated children in 14 residential facilities throughout Florida. That's 25% of the state's facilities!

**100%  
CAPACITY**

Our Day School continued with 100% capacity enrollment. The Day School is one of the largest and most highly respected private providers for families in Hillsborough and Pasco counties.

DONATIONS**

School supplies were provided for the 850+ students at Mort Elementary School. We are honored to serve alongside other local organizations partnering with Mort Elementary as a community school.

500**

We had a record-breaking 483 in attendance at our host site for The Global Leadership Summit.
