



UNIFORM CHANGEOVER TERM 2, 2017

Dear Parents and Caregivers

Students are expected to be in winter uniform at the beginning of Term 2. The full uniform is available at Andersons by the fountain in Victoria Avenue. They also stock good quality second hand uniform items. I have included the uniform prescription here for you and it is also available on the School website.

Please observe the following points:

- Jacket code. There are plenty of suitable options available, with black being the acceptable colour. Students are not to wear camouflage jackets, or hoodies. Hoodies issued via sports teams are meant to be worn for sporting fixtures only.
- The girls' skirt length is mid-calf, half way between the knee and the ankle.
- Formal shoes or dress shoes (ie. shoes with 'pointy' toes) may only be worn by boys who are in Years 12 or 13, and then only with formal uniform (dress trousers, white shirt and tie). **All shoes are lace up.**
- Shaving – boys are expected to be cleanly shaven.
- Long hair is to be tied up for the duration of the school day – both sexes.

There will be a uniform check within the first few days of the new term beginning.

We do appreciate your support in this regard. The standard of our students' personal presentation reflects their pride in being a pupil at this school.

This year the School, in conjunction with the Board of Trustees, will be conducting a uniform review. These are done triannually, and while there is no time frame set at this point, it is usually done in Term 3. This will be your opportunity to express your opinions and make suggestions about the uniform.

Girls' Winter Uniform

Skirt	Tartan (Ancient Hunting Chisholm) skirt worn at mid-calf length.
Shirt	Long-sleeved white shirt worn tucked in.
Tie	School tie
Jersey	Green woollen 'V' necked jersey with School crest or WHS 'Polar fleece' with school crest.
Shoes	Plain black flat leather lace up traditional style school shoes.
Pantihose/Tights	Black.
Socks	Black plain socks

Boys' Winter Uniform

Trousers	Black dress trousers (with front creases). Must be worn with white long sleeved shirt and school tie. Formal uniform can only be worn by students in Years 12 and 13.
Shorts	Grey shorts with self-supporting top
Shirts	Grey long sleeved shirt with shorts or white long-sleeved dress shirt with tie and dress trousers
Tie	School Tie (worn with formal uniform only)
Shoes	Plain black leather lace up traditional style school shoes. With Formal uniform only: plain black leather lace up 'formal' shoes.
Socks	With long trousers – black or grey With shorts - grey with Whanganui High School colours around tops.
Jersey	Green woollen 'V' necked jersey with school crest.
Belt	Plain black belt only.

For everyone:

Jacket	Regulation black showerproof jacket with WHS crest. Regulation black rain jacket with WHS crest, fleece lined WHS polar fleece jacket. Plain black jacket with no logo.
Sunhat	WHS green brimmed sunhat.
Rainwear	Plain waterproof raincoat.
Scarf/ Gloves	WHS green (optional)
