"TRANSITIONS"

As we enter the month of June, I cannot help but think about the many transitions that traditionally occur during these weeks

of early summer. For our children and youth, June brings the end of another school year and the much-anticipated beginning of their vacation. It also marks their transition from one grade to the next. It may bring a move to a new school. For some of our youth, June marks that transition from high school to college or into the workforce. Trustee Corner

The past few months have been very busy for your WUMC Trustees! We finished off 2016 with a much-needed

lighting retrofit in the lower Ed Wing and some offices. During Lent, the Library and lower Ed Wing classrooms got new modular carpeting, hooray! Painting of Fellowship Hall, the main stairwell, and classrooms commenced, with ongoing painting in the Ed Wing. Many other small but important tasks have been taking place in the background to keep the building in good working order, and to improve our efficiency and environmental impact.

As part of our ongoing effort to make the best use of our church home to support the WUMC mission and vision, Trustees have developed a strategy to create a men's restroom on the main level. Now half of our church family won't need to 'hold it' until getting downstairs! We will simultaneously create an ADA compliant family restroom and spruce up the existing women's restroom to make our church more welcoming, accommodating, and accessible. Trustees are also working closely with the Memorials Team to improve our maple garden in the front lawn. The walking area will be improved with engravable pavers, and will link the sidewalks for better circulation while also creating spots for rest and reflection in the shade. More info on this to come very soon!

Did you know:

➤ Our annual budget for gas and electricity is \$21,600? That's an average of \$1,800 per month! We are investing in high-efficiency mechanical and lighting equipment each year in an effort to control this expense.

- Our gardens required 21 cubic yards of mulch in 2016 and 14 cubic yards in 2017! Many thanks to everyone who volunteers to maintain garden beds around our property.
- Trustees periodically review each service contract associated with the church property. This includes insurance, snow removal, lawn care, mechanical, pest control, office equipment, utilities, and instrument tuning.



Medicare News

Marketplace Coverage and Medicare.....

Today I would like to bring to your attention that CMS (Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services) is offering **equitable relief** to certain Medicare beneficiaries who did not enroll timely for Medicare Part B.

The equitable relief... will waive the late penalty and wait times for enrollment. The offer ends in September. This offer is available to <u>current Medicare beneficiaries</u> with Medicare Part A and Marketplace coverage, AND declined Medicare Part B. It is also available to individuals who were previously dually enrolled in Medicare Part A and had Marketplace coverage; subsequently enrolled in B and incurred a late enrollment penalty.

So, why is CMS offering equitable relief?

Because if you have Medicare and Marketplace coverage... Medicare Part A meets the legal requirement for minimum essential coverage and if individuals with Medicare Part A remain on the Marketplace (considered dually enrolled) they are not eligible to receive premium and cost-sharing assistance. These individuals may have to pay back their advanced payments of the premium tax credit (APTC) when they file their tax return.


