Please read the following information carefully, as there are a number of changes to our normal School programme due to take place over the next few weeks.

OPEN DAY ARRANGEMENTS - 2017

The annual Open Day at Whanganui High School will take place on **Thursday 15 June.** The main purpose of Open Day, is to give 2017 Year 8 students and their caregivers, the opportunity to see the School's facilities and the programmes offered to students. Two sessions will be held during Open Day: 4.00 to 6.00 pm, and 7.00 to 9.00 pm. As many of the rooms in the School are used, and a large number of students are involved, time is needed to both set up displays/activities and to tidy them away. Therefore, the following arrangements have been made:

Thursday 15 June:

We will run Form Time and periods 1, 2 and 3 as normal, and students will be dismissed from school at 12.50pm.

Once dismissed, it is expected that students will go to their <u>own homes</u>, and not into town. Supervision will be available for bus students and other students requiring it. Please advise the Student Centre (Phone 349 0177) if supervision is required.

Friday 16 June:

Students will be expected at school by **8.55 am**. Form Time will commence at 9.00am and will be followed by a five period day, which will finish at 3.05pm as usual.

On **Tuesday 27 June** our staff are involved in inter school moderation meetings.
