The long road to healing begins here

Most families do not have the resources to cope with the incredibly difficult grieving process following a death, especially when young children and teenagers are involved. Suncoast Kid's Place provides understanding and support in a safe and nurturing environment. Children, teens, and families can share their experience as they move through the process of grieving the death of a significant person.



Through peer support groups, discussion, education, and play, Suncoast Kid's Place provides the resources necessary to help families grieve a devastating death. Families also find strength and joy in sharing memories of someone special. Here, participants have the opportunity to meet others who have also experienced the death of a parent, primary caregiver, sibling, friend, or other significant person.

This program is free of charge and available to all families regardless of when the death occurred.

Grouped together by age categories, children and teens participate twice a month in 90-minute sessions that include both talking time and play time. During the sessions, participants are encouraged to express their feelings and thoughts through play and activities. Children have expressed that coming to Suncoast Kid's Place is fun and enjoy being with peers who have also experienced a death. All groups are led by a professional staff member and trained volunteer facilitators. Therapy dogs are a key component to group sessions for the kids and teens to enjoy.

Caregivers are encouraged to attend the adult group that meets concurrently with every children's group. An adult must remain on campus.

Suncoast Kid's Place does not provide private therapy.
