- WSS Junior Sportswoman of the Year (Complete Page 2, 3, 4 & 5)**
Open to any individual female student aged under 16 years as at 1 January 2017, who has excelled as an individual or in a team in one or more sports within the qualifying period. This is the top performance competing at the highest level (local, regional, zone, national or international).
- WSS Junior Sportsman of the Year (Complete Page 2, 3, 4 & 5)**
Open to any individual male student aged under 16 years as at 1 January 2017, who has excelled as an individual or in a team in one or more sports within the qualifying period. This is the top performance competing at the highest level (local, regional, zone, national or international).
- WSS Senior Sportsman of the Year (Complete Page 2, 3, 4 & 5)**
Open to any individual male student aged over 16 years as at 1 January 2017, who has excelled as an individual or in a team in one or more sports within the qualifying period. This is the top performance competing at the highest level (local, regional, zone, national or international).
- WSS Senior Sportswoman of the Year (Complete Page 2, 3, 4 & 5)**
Open to any individual female student aged over 16 years as at 1 January 2017, who has excelled as an individual or in a team in one or more sports within the qualifying period. This is the top performance competing at the highest level (local, regional, zone, national or international).
- WSS Official of the Year (Complete Page 2, 3, 4 & 5)**
Open to all student officials who have excelled in & displayed an outstanding performance as a referee/umpire/judge during the qualifying period. They should show a commitment to developing as an umpire through the year and display the best qualities and characteristics of an official (e.g. fairness, communication, consistency, confidence, integrity, enjoyment, development).
- WSS Coach of the Year (Complete Page 2, 3, 4 & 5)**
Open to all student coaches who have excelled in performing at their role/displayed an outstanding performance during the qualifying period. They should display impressive coaching qualities and attributes and exemplify fair play, a positive coaching style and understanding and have success at coaching their athletes in skill and game development within their sport/s.
- WSS Junior Team of the Year (Complete Page 2, 3, 4 & 5)**
Open to a school team containing students that are Under 16 as at 1 January 2017 who have excelled in competition during the qualifying period. If the team is a mix of junior and senior students then the nomination will fall within the senior team category. This is the top performance competing at the highest level (local, regional, zone, national or international).
- WSS Senior Team of the Year (Complete Page 2, 3, 4 & 5)**
Open to a school team containing students that are Over 16 as at 1 January 2017 who have excelled in competition during the qualifying period. If the team is a mix of junior and senior students then the nomination will fall within the senior team category. This is the top performance competing at the highest level (local, regional, zone, national or international).
- WSS Contribution to Sport Recognition (Complete page 2, 3 & 6)**
Open to any individual who has exemplified fair play in all aspects of their sporting activities during their tenure at school. They must have shown leadership, role modeling, service before self and a high level of commitment to supporting & promoting sport at their school. There may be multiple recipients for this recognition category.
- WSS Recognition of Performance in Local Competition - Team or Individual Sport (Complete page 2, 3, 7 & 8)**
Open to any individual or team, male, female or mixed, junior or senior who has represented their school and have displayed the best performance participating in a local competition (local competition is any league that runs 6 weeks or more and is offered and played in Whanganui, Ruapehu or Rangitikei). Must include an explanation of how the individual or team worked towards achieving this result. If individuals or teams (from Whanganui, Ruapehu and/or Rangitikei) are forced to play in a league outside of Whanganui due to NO local league offered in Whanganui, they can also be nominated for this recognition. There may be multiple recipients awarded for this category as it is a recognition of performance.
- Recognition of Achievement (Complete Page 2, 3, 4 & 5)**
This category is open to nominees that compete in, officiate or coach activities that are not recognised as official 'sports'. These are activities that are not included in Sport New Zealand's list of sports <http://www.sportnz.org.nz/get-into-sport/find-a-sport>) and/or not included/recognised in the NZSSC census eg. Sport stacking, crossfit.
Open to any individual or team, male, female or mixed, junior or senior who achieved at a high level in their chosen activity. Must include an explanation of how the individual, team, official or coach has worked towards achieving this result. There may be multiple recipients awarded for this category (for both individuals and teams – athletes, officials & coaches) as it is a recognition of achievement. Judges will look carefully at the level of achievement to ensure worthy of recognition.
