Pastoral Reflections

Transitions

With spring turning to summer, we find ourselves in a season of transitions. In the East Ohio Conference of The United Methodist Church summer is the time of clergy appointment changes. I continue to be honored to

serve as the senior pastor of this amazing congregation. This year, we welcome a new associate pastor to our staff. Bishop Malone has announced the appointment of Rev. J. Paige Boyer as the associate pastor at Westlake UMC and she will have pastoral responsibilities at both of our campuses. Please join me in welcoming Rev. Paige to Westlake UMC. I also want to share with you that it has been announced that effective July 1 Bishop Malone will appoint Pastor Mikayla Kovacik, our pastoral intern last summer, to serve as the solo pastor of Wellsville UMC and Highlandtown UMC in the Mahoning Valley District. As Pastor Mikayla finishes her second of three years of seminary, she will attend licensing school at the end of May. She will become a licensed local pastor at Annual Conference. Please join me in congratulating Pastor Mikayla. I ask that you pray for all churches and clergy who are in the midst of transition this summer.

July 1 marks the official beginning of Westlake UMC being one church with two locations: the Westlake campus and the Simpson campus. I want to personally thank all of you for your prayers and ask you to continue to pray for this church and both of our campuses. We have witnessed the amazing movement of the Holy Spirit which has led us to this point in time. The Holy Spirit has guided us and God truly has provided for us as WUMC steps out in faith in a new and very exciting manner. In the midst of all of the work on the many operational action items that

need to be completed as we move into this bold future for the church, I want all of us to STOP and PRAY. We are thankful for the ways God has showed up, has moved among us, and has helped us step out in faith. God has carried us to this point, and through prayer and discernment, I am confident that God will be our constant companion guiding us in this new ministry.

God has blessed the Westlake and Simpson congregations with very gifted individuals whom I am convinced have both the abilities and the spiritual strength to accomplish the tasks that lie before us. A one church with two locations transition and implementation team was formed in April under the oversight of our leadership council. Kay Martin chairs this team with assistance from Carole Miller, a member-at-large on leadership council. The transition team includes leaders from both campuses representing staff parish relations, finance, trustees, communication/marketing, faith formation, and general administration. The team is meeting every two weeks to provide updates on each area's work on their respective action items. The leadership council will also monitor the steps being taken over the next year to accomplish our initial missional objectives for the Simpson campus. Watch for updates in worship bulletins and in future newsletters on the important work of the transition team. If you have any questions during the transition phase, please do not hesitate to contact Kay Martin and me.

It is an exciting time at Westlake United Methodist Church. I ask for your prayers as we move through this season of transitions. May we always continue to be faithful followers of Jesus Christ and may our work in His name bear fruit that will last.

A TIME OF CHANGE AND BEGINNINGS

Our Church has seen a number of changes in staff over the last year including the hiring of a new choir director and the departure of our Christian education director. As we move into this new time of change with the creation of the WUMC Simpson campus, we want to provide a look at our changes and clarify who's who moving forward.

Rev. Paige Boyer will be joining our staff on July 1 as new Associate Pastor. See the article at right for full details of her appointment.

Ellie Peiffer has been an integral part of our staff for many years. We are so happy to announce her promotion to Director of Faith Formation, a position that is 25 hours a week. She will be overseeing Christian education for the whole of the congregation from infants to older adults. With her tremendous gifts for visioning, compassion and spirituality Ellie brings much to this position. With Ellie's new role, **Kay Martin**, who had graciously stepped in to manage our Sunday school program over the last several months, will be completing that responsibility as of June 3, for which we are extremely grateful.

Patti Barnes has been our Nursery Coordinator for the past seven years, and has recently announced her resignation from that role so that she can spend more time with her own growing children. We are appreciative for all that Patti has done for our program, including time spent to help fill the gap alongside Kay with the Christian education program.

With these changes, we are excited to announce a new position that will be filled over the next few months. A part-time **Congregational Connections Coordinator** will report to Ellie and help recruit and organize volunteers for a variety of situations, including classroom teachers and event volunteers.

Change can be difficult but also can be a time of renewal – we are blessed with a staff of talented and dedicated people who continue to help our congregation embrace change and be renewed in Christ.

A LITTLE ABOUT REV. PAIGE

- Rev. Paige is currently serving as Pastor at both Cove United Methodist (Lakewood) and Lake Shore United Methodist (Avon), so she is used to being busy!
- She received her Master of Divinity in 2015 from the Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary in Illinois. While in Illinois she spent time working with the Urban Village Church helping to create inclusive communities within the city of Chicago.
- She also received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Ashland University in Public Communications and Electronic Media Production, and then spent 10 years working in Public Relations before answering her call to ministry. For this reason, she will be focused on many of our outreach programs, including marketing and communications initiatives, with Joyce Masterson (our skilled communications coordinator) reporting to her. Once Rev. Paige is officially on staff at WUMC, we'll be able to more fully determine her other areas of responsibility.

Currently a Provisional Elder, Rev. Paige will be fully ordained at this year's Annual Conference at Lakeside on June 13.






