PW Fall Bazaar

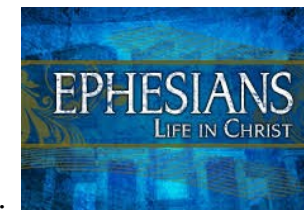
