Level 1 NCEA requires you to attain 80 credits You must gain Level 1 Numeracy and Level 1 Literacy


Credits earned in Year 10 are carried forward

Level 2 and Level 3 require 60 credits at or above L2 /L3 respectively

- * All Semester Courses lead to a similar Year 12 Course






FUTURE FOCUS WEEK
