Level 1: 80 credits required

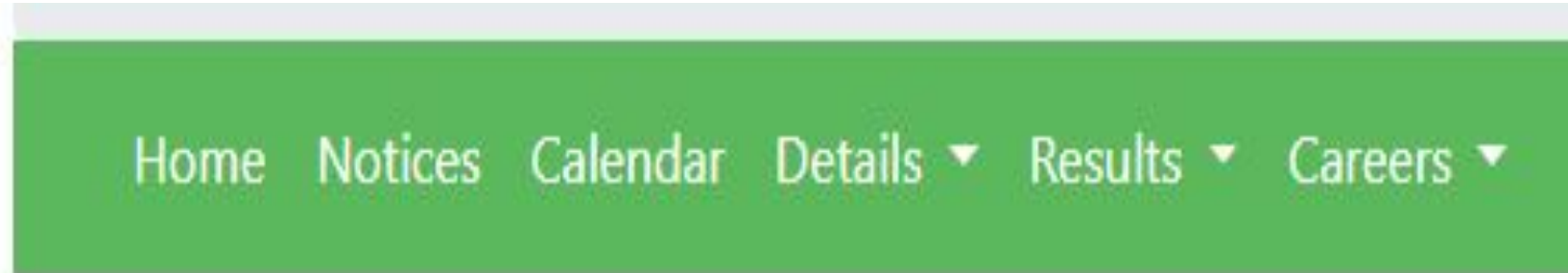
Level 2 / 3: 60 credits at or above the specific level

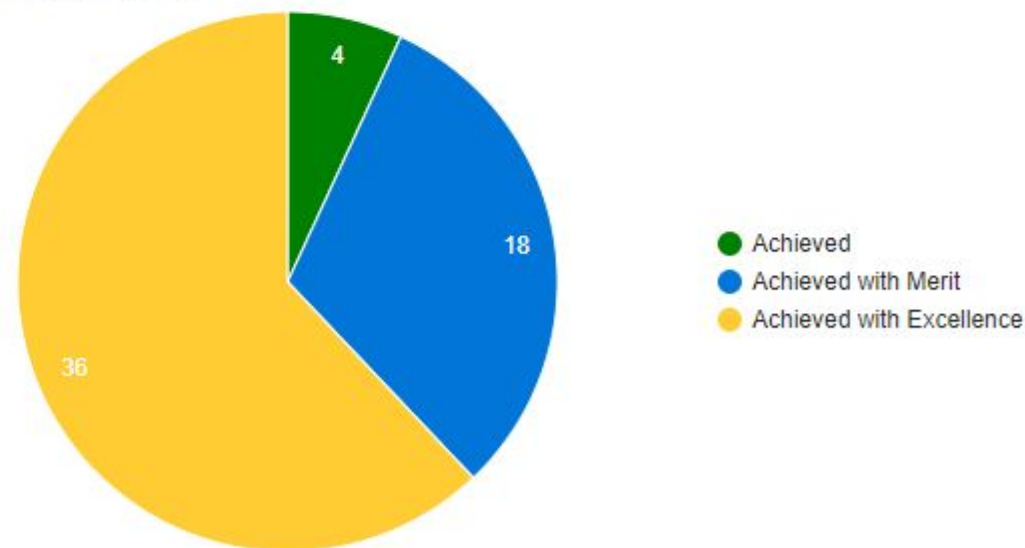

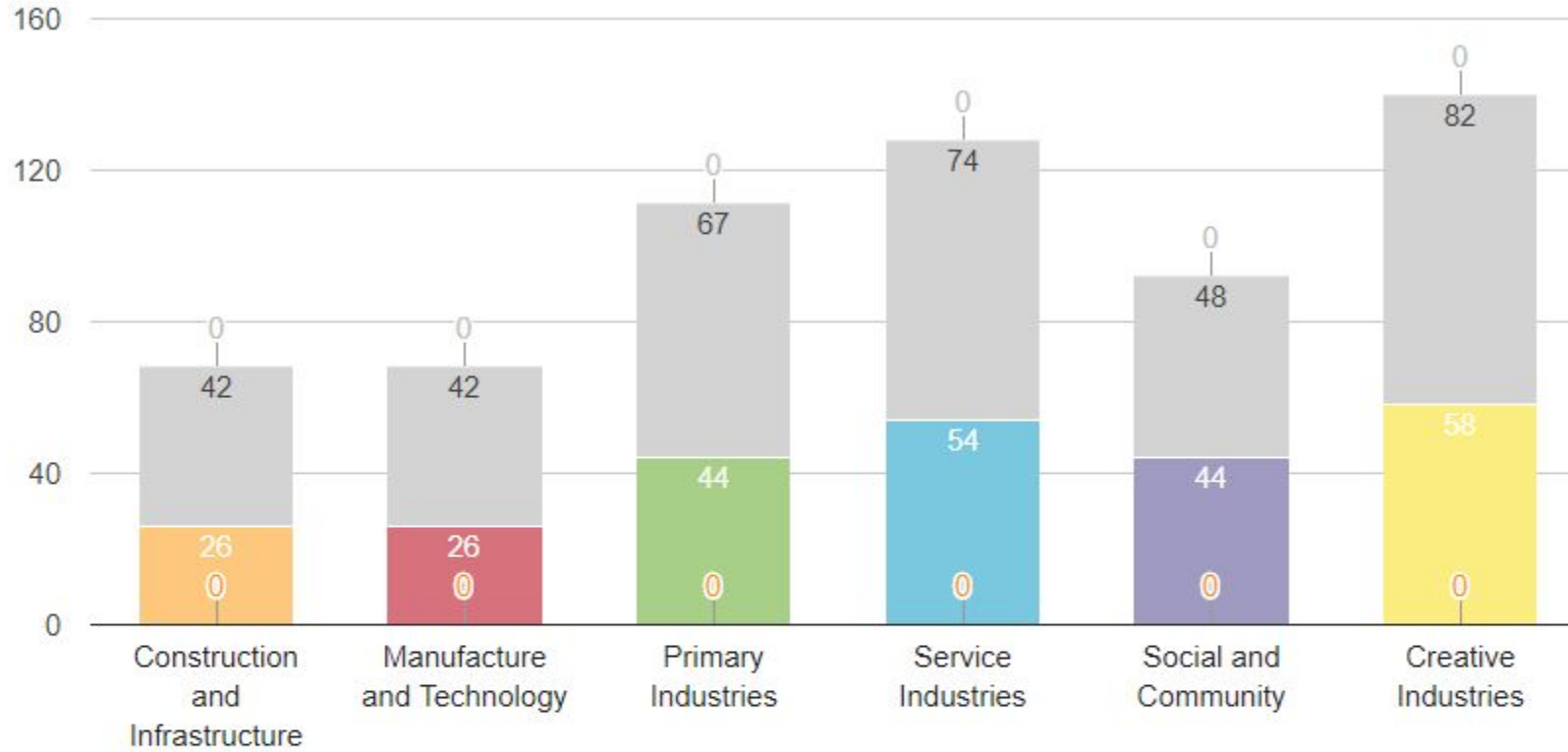
