The Native American Community Clinic (“NACC”) is a non-profit Community Health Center/ Federally Qualified Health Center that has been serving Native Americans and others in the Phillips neighborhood and Twin Cities metropolitan area since 2003. Founded by three female physicians and a nurse practitioner who had worked together in the neighborhood for a combined total of 65 years, the NACC’s mission is to promote wellness and health maintenance in Native American families, decrease health disparities in Native Americans in the metropolitan area, and provide care regardless of ability to pay.

### Tooth Brushing Technique

You've been brushing your teeth your whole life, but are you getting the most from your efforts? The following technique will help you get the most thorough clean.

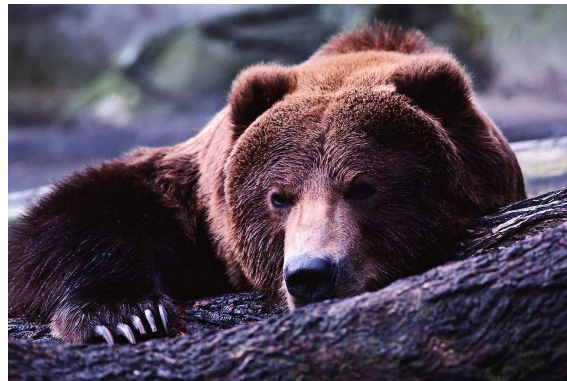
1. On the outer and inner surfaces, brush your teeth at a 45-degree angle in short half-tooth-wide strokes against the gum line.
2. On chewing surfaces, hold the brush flat and brush back and forth.
3. On inside surfaces of front teeth, tilt brush vertically and use gentle up and down strokes with toe of brush.
4. Brush the tongue in a back-to-front sweeping motion to remove food particles and freshen your mouth.
